AS THEY EXISTED IN 1750

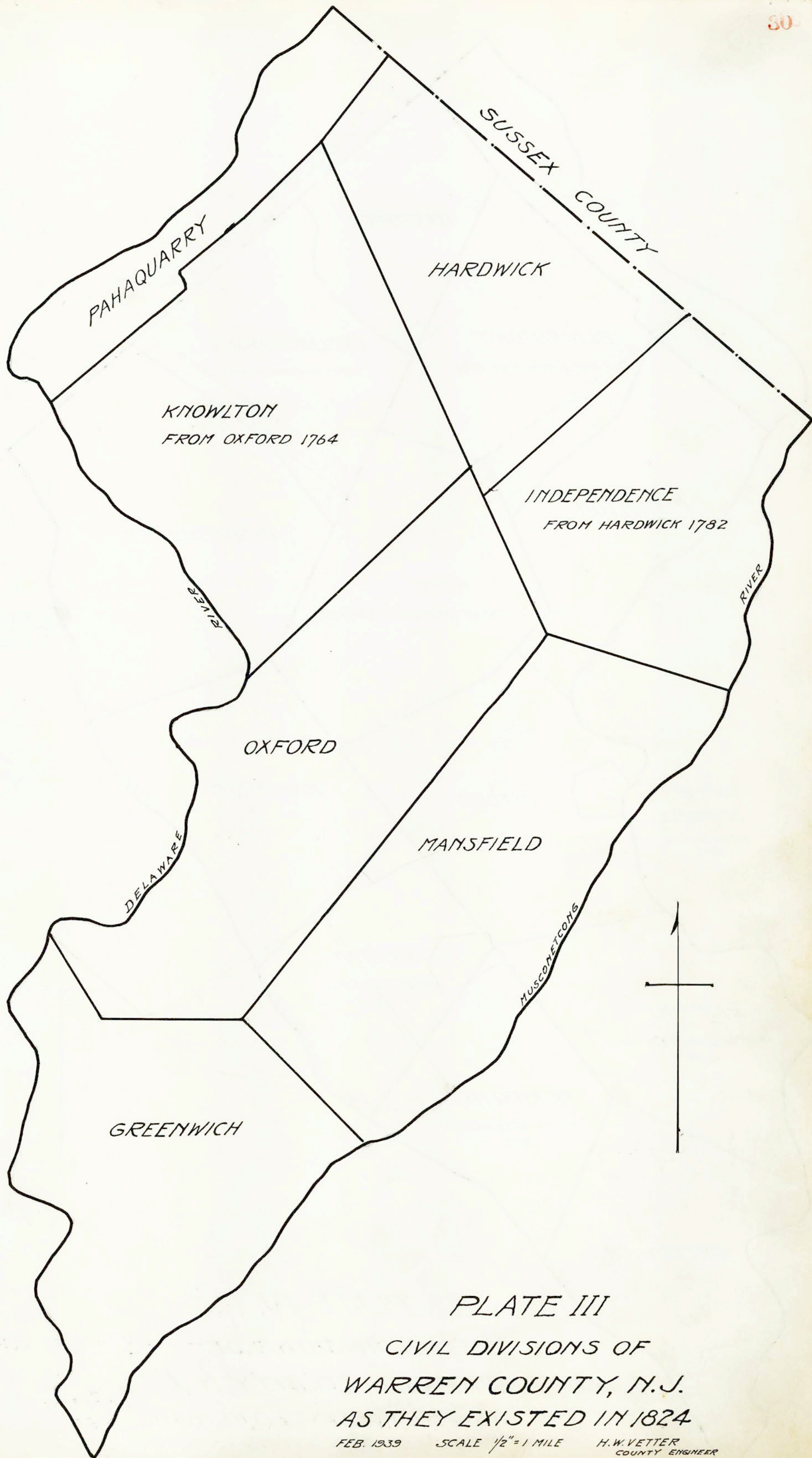


PLATE III

 COUNTY ENGINEER

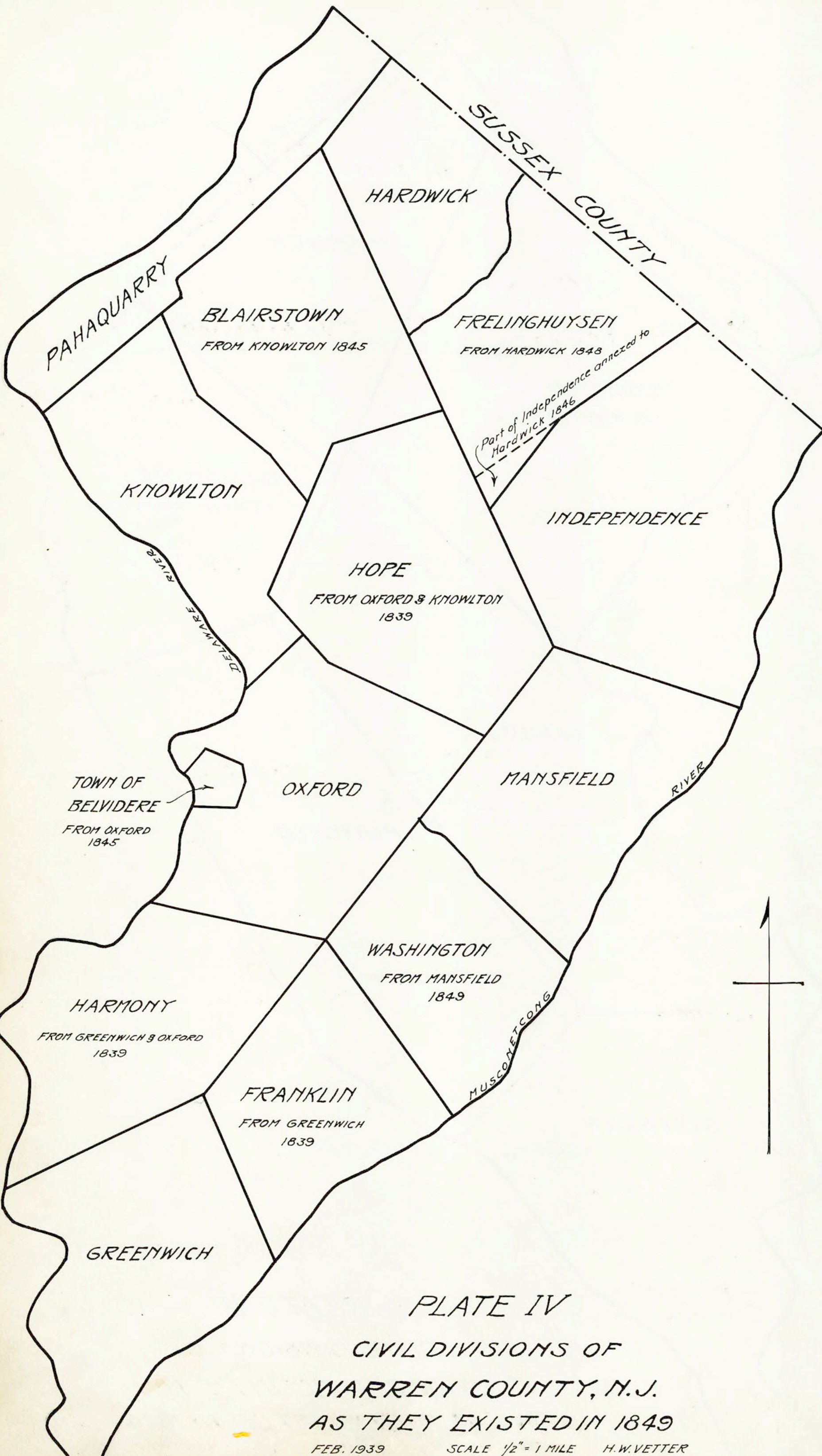


PLATE IV

 AS THEY EXISTED IN 1849

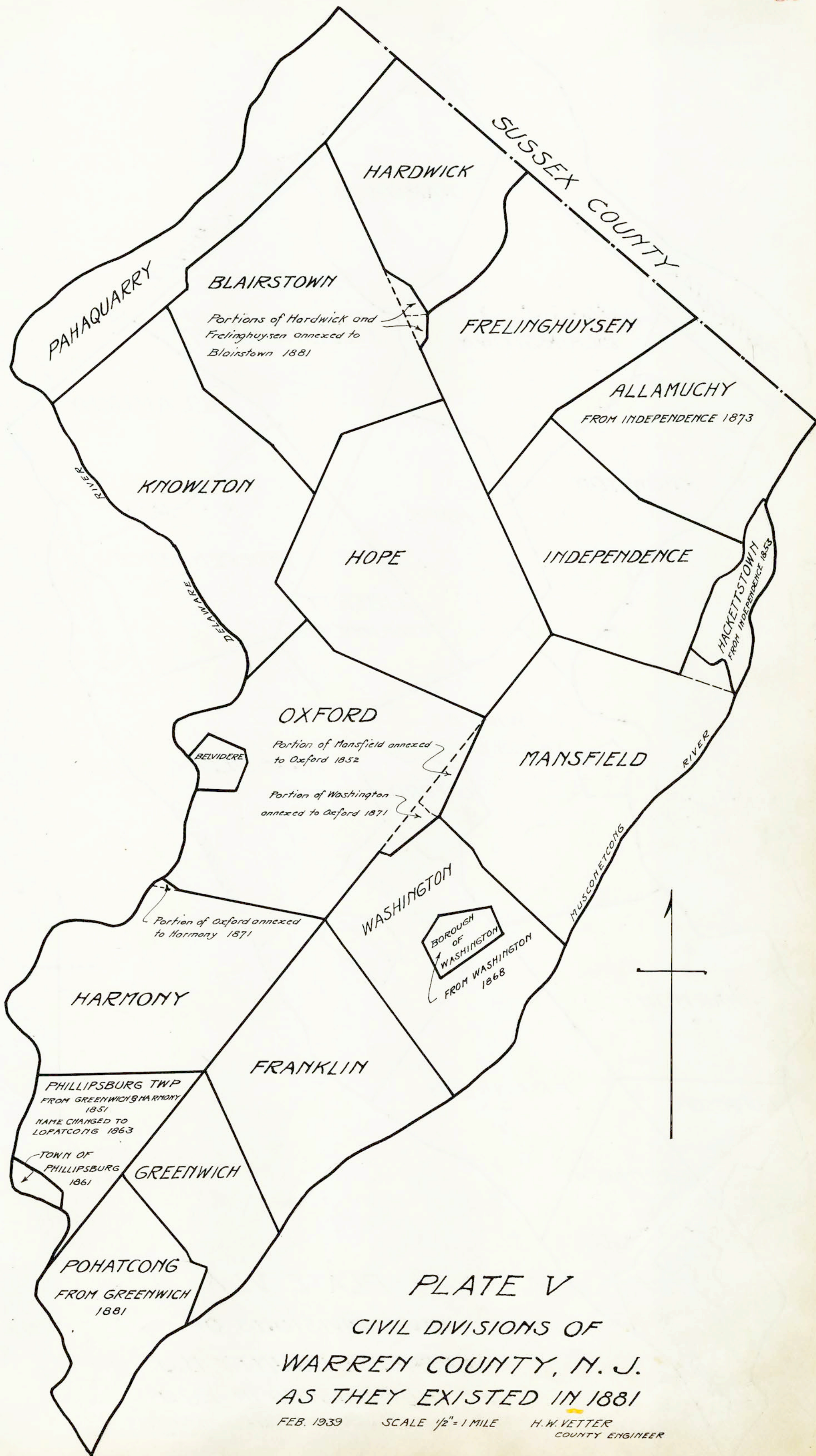


PLATE V

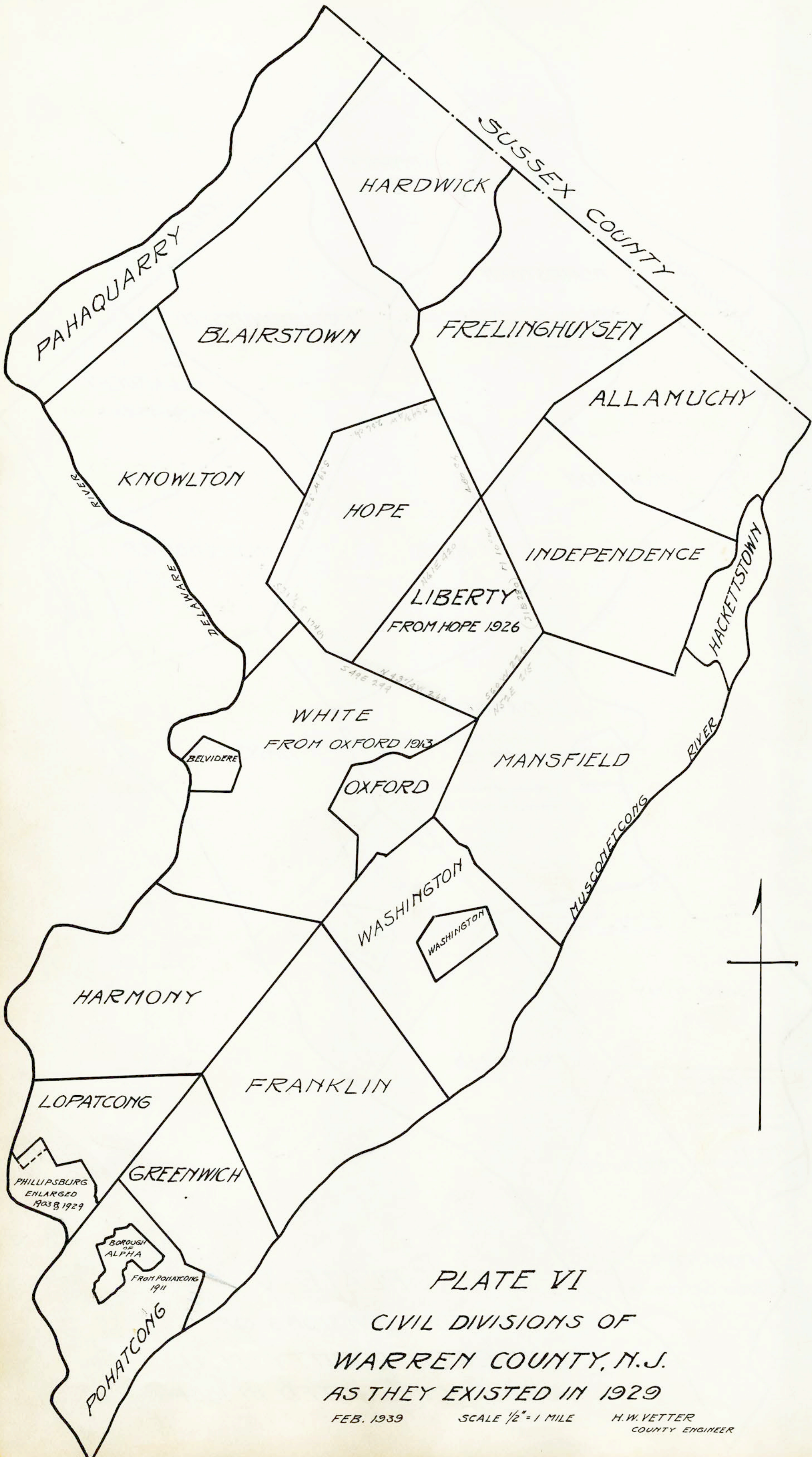


PLATE VI
